

Connector Corner

On End of Rectangle

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Procedure:

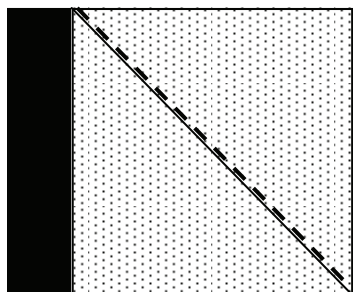
1. Lightly draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back of the connector square.



2. Place (1) " Fabric connector square on the end of (1) rectangle, with the diagonal line across the corner and matching the outside edges as shown.



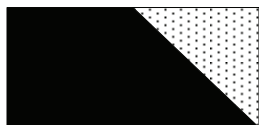
3. Sew beside the drawn diagonal line on the outside corner side.



Enlarged corner



4. Press the Connector square to the corner.



5. Ensure that the unit is still the same size as the rectangle when you started, either re-sew the seam or trim if required. Unfold the pressed fabric and trim excess leaving a 1/4" seam.
