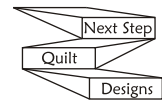


Flying Geese - No Waste Method

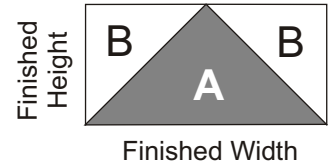
Makes 4 Flying Geese that are the same colors, finished width is twice the finished height, and includes 1/4" seams.



Cut:

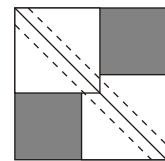
Fabric A - One square = $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " + finished width = _____

Fabric B - Four squares = $\frac{7}{8}$ " + finished height = _____

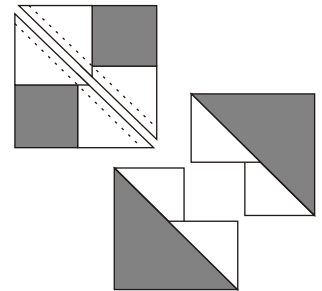


1. On the back of the Four Fabric B squares draw a diagonal line.
2. Place One Fabric B square right sides together and on top of One Fabric A square, in both the lower right corner and the upper left corner, lining up the drawn diagonal lines.

Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn diagonal line.

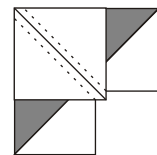


3. Cut on the drawn diagonal line. Press to Fabric B squares. Trim dog ears.

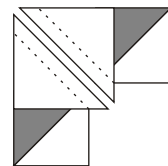


4. Place One Fabric B square, right sides together, on top of the remaining Fabric A corner with the drawn diagonal line in the corner.

Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn diagonal line.



5. Cut on the drawn diagonal line. Press to Fabric B. Trim dog ears.
6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5.



Yields Four Flying Geese units.
