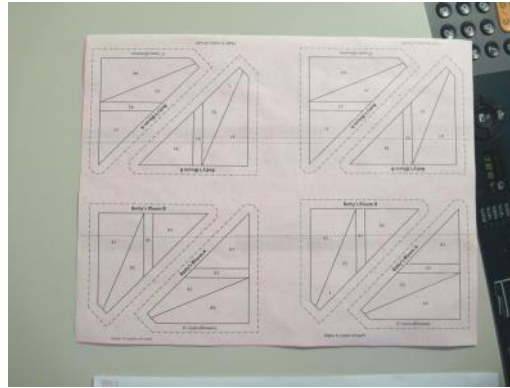
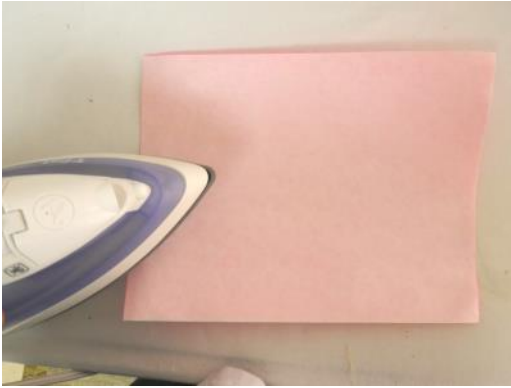


PAPERLESS PAPER PIECING

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Next Step Quilt Designs

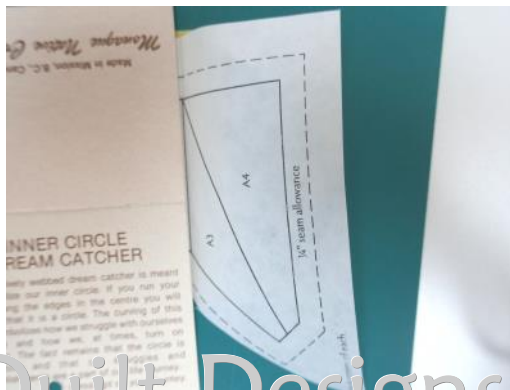
1. Press butcher paper (white) to a sheet of regular paper (pink). Photocopy or print four copies of the pattern on the butcher paper.



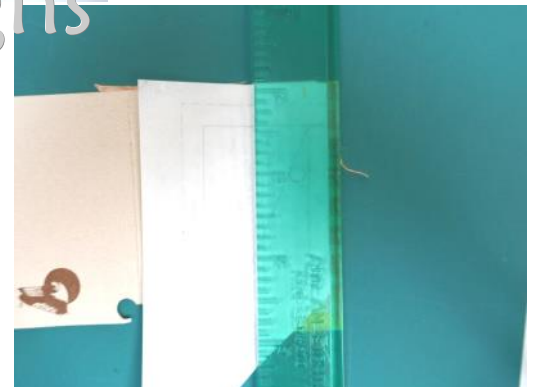
2. Peel off from the regular paper, cut out the pieces and sort into right and left groups. Press butcher paper (white) to a sheet of regular paper (pink). Photocopy or print four copies of the pattern on the butcher paper. Cut fabrics the same shape as each section $\frac{1}{2}$ " larger all around. Organize fabrics for each unit.



3. Lightly press fabric for section 1 to wax side of section 1. Using cardstock place the edge on the line between section 1 and section 2. Using the Add An Eighth ruler trim seam allowance.



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- Place section 2 fabric rights sides together on fabric 1 matching the seam allowance edge. Pin in place. With the paper folded back on itself, hold it up to the light to make sure section 2 fabric will cover section 2 on the paper with at least $\frac{1}{8}$ " around the seam lines. Adjust fabric if need be. Again with paper folded back on itself, begin sew directly beside the fold. Do not worry if you catch the folded edge in places as it will be easy to tear away.



- Carefully press fabric 2 to wax side.



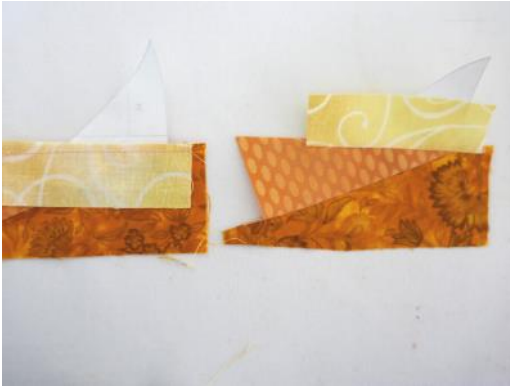
- Check to make sure fabric covers section 2. Using the cardstock and Add An Eighth ruler, trim seam allowance.



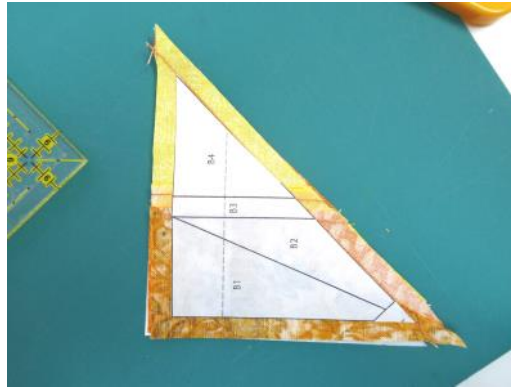
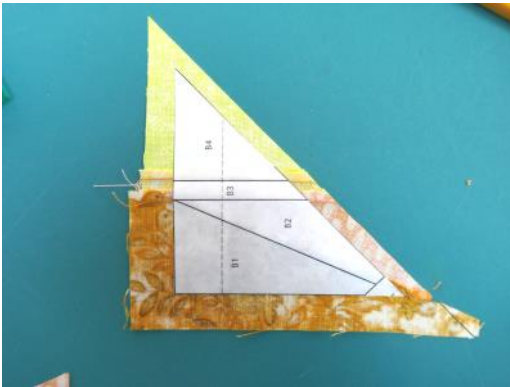
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7. Repeat steps 4 through 6 to the remaining sections.

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8. Trim around the outside edge leaving a 1/4" seam allowance all around.



9. After completing all the sections, sew the units together, matching the outside edges and seams. Stitch directly beside the paper outside edge. I pressed seams open to help with the bulk.



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
